
COMMUNITY-CAMPUS EVENT PLAN RESULTS REPORT JUNE 14, 2023

Summary

CONFERENCE REPORT



On Wednesday, June 14, a plenary session was held with attendees from different countries. Among the main ones, we did an exchange of knowledge between Mexico and Spain. Miriam Salvador, director of the Law Program at the Camilo Jose Cela University, Carlotta Tovar, director of the Camilo José Cela Foundation, Valeria Peña tiktoker and defender of rights and international activist, and Murtazar Haidari, a refugee in Spain, they participated as speakers. We met in a plenary session that lasted one hour to discuss the role of Afghan women, the opportunities, and why it is important in society to raise awareness of the situation in which these women find themselves due to the Taliban regime.
