# Higher Education in the World Report

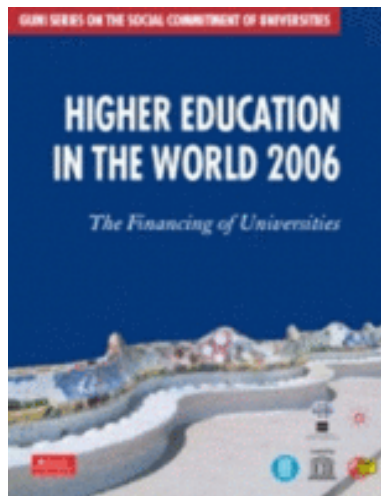


The Report is a **collective work** published as part of the GUNI *Series on the Social Commitment of Universities*.

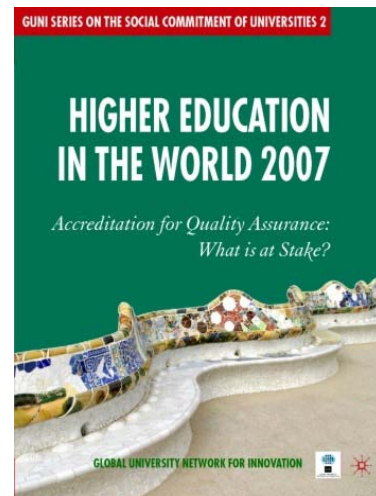
It is the result of a **global and regional analysis** of higher education in the world. The Report reflects on the **key issues and challenges** facing higher education and its institutions in the 21st century.



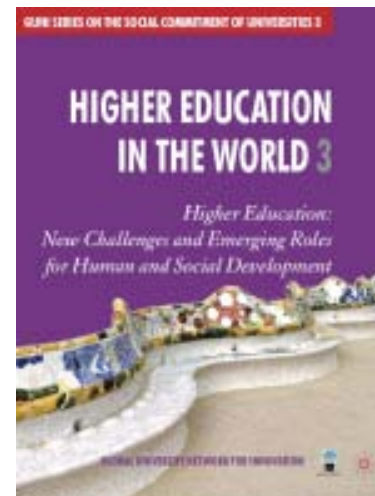
